



# COURSE DESCRIPTION

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## COLLEGE COUNSELING & ADMISSIONS PREP PRIVATE CLASSES (for high school students)

This is a college admissions preparatory course offered in the fall (September through December), winter/spring (February through May), and year-round (September through June) to students on a private, one-on-one basis. It is intended for those who wish to take charge and maximize their chances of gaining access to the college(s) of their choice. Through carefully planned classes and assignments, the course provides students with the necessary tools and guidance to tackle all aspects of the application process thoroughly and with quality results. Course content mirrors that for group-class students but with all instruction and counseling in one-on-one classes with Eric Cohen, Mercer Education's owner and director.

### COURSE HIGHLIGHTS

Each student completes a "college readiness" assessment and works with Mr. Cohen, who formulates an action plan for each student to meet his or her admissions criteria. Course content and highlights include:
