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# SAT MATH PREP - GROUP CLASS

## (High School Students)

This course is designed to prepare students for the math portions of the SAT and other similar standardized tests. Students explore the types of logic and problem solving questions seen on the SAT by dissecting the math behind the problems and developing a toolkit of skills with which to approach problem-solving situations. Through regular assignments and supplemental material and exercises, students acquire a strong foundation in fundamental concepts and skills and have the option to pursue advanced topics at either a challenging or more moderate pace. Additionally, students become familiar with and practice effective test-taking strategies, develop time management skills, identify areas of weaknesses, and receive in-depth feedback and score analysis from experienced instructors. The course also addresses some SAT Subject Test topics. For groups in 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grade, there is preparation for the PSAT in September and October.

- Meets *once a week* for 1 hour and 50 minutes.
- Class size limited to no more than 6 students per group.
- Students receive free assessment upon enrollment and are grouped according to skill level and age.
- Parents receive a Progress Report every four months with scores, comments, and recommendations.
- Groups meet year round; classes are usually held on weekdays 4–9pm and weekends 9am–5pm.
